HOUSING

We will introduce controls on private rented property, to guarantee minimum standards, and to ensure that no one is forced to accept huge increases in their rent every year. We will build 500,000 socially rented homes to provide new, affordable homes for families and the young.

YOUNG PEOPLE

We will scrap the tuition fees that put so many off studying for a degree. We will reinstate the Education Maintenance Grant to ensure that those from the poorest backgrounds are not blocked from attending university and achieving their potential.

OUR NHS

We must reverse the decline in funding for the NHS, and ensure all services are delivered by public bodies, not private companies. We will give mental health parity with physical health through equality in funding and investment.

OUR ENVIRONMENT

We must free ourselves from the threat of climate change. Investment in renewables and phasing out fossil fuels will create jobs, clean air, rivers, parks, and gardens, reduce flooding dangers and prevent fracking from industrialising our countryside.
